

### Kingdom Knowledge: The Parables of Jesus

Normally, we don't think of Jesus as being divisive. He was usually all about gathering everyone up and bringing them under the banner of the Kingdom of God. But Jesus intentionally divided the people that heard His teaching. In Matthew 13:10-12, Jesus' disciples asked Him why He spoke in parables and His answer was that they were permitted to hear the secrets of the Kingdom of Heaven but others would not. That sounds divisive to me!

Jesus' use of parables served to divide those who came to hear Him into two groups: His disciples and everyone else. His disciples would be able to learn from the parables. But to those who were not His disciples, their meaning was obscure. By using parables, His disciples would be enriched, but others would be further impoverished in Kingdom knowledge. It reminds me of the Parable of the Talents. Each servant is entrusted with a certain amount of money by the Master to care for; one of them increases the value while one just holds on to the original value. It is as if those willing to invest the knowledge of Christ will gain in abundance, but those who are just in it for the miracles or just to hold on to what Jesus teaches on the surface will lose what little they have.

While teaching with parables was not unique to Jesus (rabbis had used them for years to make a certain point more teachable), He took parables to a different, divine level. By investing in understanding the pearls of wisdom found in Kingdom knowledge, hearers will be transformed into true Kingdom dwellers. **Coupled with the instruction of the Holy Spirit, parables allow those who have faith to learn about the Kingdom.**Those without faith and the Spirit are unable to understand the truths of Jesus' parables.

Join us beginning April 14 through May 26 as we deeply investigate Jesus' teachings through parables you have chosen to hear about: "The Ten Virgins" (Matthew 25:1-13), "The Good Samaritan" (Luke 10:30-37), "The Judgement of the Nations" aka "The Sheep and the Goats" (Matthew 25:31-46), "The Pharisee and the Tax Collector" (Luke 18:10-14), and "Counting the Cost" (Luke 14:28-33). Get a jump start on investing in Kingdom knowledge by reading these parables in advance!


